

RESOLUTION NO. ____

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PRESCOTT VALLEY, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF ARIZONA, CALLING UPON THE STATE OF ARIZONA (THROUGH ITS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION) TO CONSIDER AS INTERCHANGE LOCATIONS FOR THE PROPOSED SR 169/FAIN ROAD CONNECTOR ROADWAY ALTERNATIVES 1 AND 1A; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL ACCORDING TO LAW.

WHEREAS, the 2006 Central Yavapai Metropolitan Planning Organization (CYMPO) Regional Transportation Study recommended a future roadway network of local and regional roads to meet 2030 travel demands, one of which was a connector road between SR 169 and Fain Road (to provide connection to I-17); and

WHEREAS, a follow-up CYMPO study in February 2009 established a preferred corridor for the new access-controlled roadway; and

WHEREAS, in September 2010 the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) initiated a study through the I-17 to Fain Road Connector Corridor Location Study and Environmental Overview to specifically identify traffic interchange locations for access into Prescott Valley; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting to solicit comment was conducted by ADOT on September 28, 2011 in Prescott Valley to present five (5) alternatives for interchange locations; and

WHEREAS, local access to the new SR 169 to Fain Road roadway will be important for continued economic growth and sustained vitality; and

WHEREAS, maintaining existing Robert Road access to SR 89A is also critical for mobility for Town residents; and

WHEREAS, Alternatives 1 and Alternative 1A (attached hereto and expressly made a part hereof) are, therefore, the preferred alternatives of the Prescott Valley Town Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Prescott Valley, Arizona, as follows:

1. That the Town of Prescott Valley hereby urges the State of Arizona (through its Department of Transportation), to consider as interchange locations for the proposed SR 169/Fain Road Connector Roadway Alternatives 1 and 1A. [See attached]

2. That this Resolution shall be effective after its passage and approval according to law.
