SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: The Governor’s Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) recently solicited grant proposals to enhance underage drinking enforcement programs throughout Arizona for the 2012 Federal Fiscal Year. Through Council’s approval, the Prescott Valley Police Department (PVPD) submitted an application to receive funding for a program which focuses on preventing and taking enforcement action on underage drinking violations throughout Prescott Valley.

On December 22, 2011, PVPD received notification from GOHS of a Federal Department of Justice grant award providing funds in the amount of \$15,000. The funds will support personnel services (overtime) and employee related expenses (benefits) to enhance underage drinking enforcement activities throughout Prescott Valley. Liquor activities include, but are not limited to, the persons under the age of 21 years purchasing, possessing and/or consuming spirituous liquor.

Acceptance of the Highway Safety Contract requires a certified Council Resolution authorizing entry into the contract with GOHS.

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: Council may either accept the GOHS 2012 Underage Alcohol Enforcement Grant Award – Contract # 2012-DOJ-016 (2011) through Resolution No. 1779 **or** decline to adopt the resolution.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to authorize the Mayor (or, in his absence, the Vice Mayor) to sign Resolution No. 1779 accepting the GOHS 2012 Underage Alcohol Enforcement Grant Award – Contract # 2012-DOJ-016 (2011), **OR** Motion not to approve Resolution No. 1779. **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends authorizing signature of Resolution No. 1779 accepting the grant award.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: There is no fiscal impact to the Town. This grant is fully reimbursable through the Governor’s Office of Highway Safety.
