**SUMMARY BACKGROUND:** The Town of Prescott Valley has participated in a multi-jurisdictional effort in collaboration with eleven (11) neighboring jurisdictions to develop an update to the Yavapai County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. The last Plan was developed and accepted by FEMA in 2006 and requires an update every five years. This current update has been funded through a federal planning grant led by Arizona Division of Emergency Management (ADEM) who hired JE Fuller Hydrology and Geomorphology to assist in the update process. Town staff members served on the planning team and attended three meetings over the past eighteen months

The updated Yavapai County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan is now ready for adoption by participating agencies as a comprehensive document to identify and guide mitigation measures to eliminate or reduce the effects of future disasters throughout Yavapai County.
