SUMMARY BACKGROUND: The Town of Prescott Valley has participated in a multi-jurisdictional effort in collaboration with eleven (11) neighboring jurisdictions to develop an update to the Yavapai County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. The last Plan was developed and accepted by FEMA in 2006 and requires an update every five years. This current update has been funded through a federal planning grant led by Arizona Division of Emergency Management (ADEM) who hired JE Fuller Hydrology and Geomorphology to assist in the update process. The Town of Prescott Valley staff members served on the planning team formed and attended three meetings over the past eighteen months in a collaborative effort to review, evaluate and update the 2006 Plan.

The current Yavapai County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan is complete and ready for adoption by participating agencies as a comprehensive document to identify and guide mitigation measures to eliminate or reduce the effects of future disasters throughout Yavapai County.

OPTION ANALYSIS: Council may adopt Resolution No. 1780 in support of the Yavapai County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan as written, propose changes to the Resolution prior to adoption, or decline to adopt such a Resolution.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to authorize the Mayor (or, in his absence, the Vice Mayor) to sign Resolution No. 1780 adopting and approving the 2011 updated Yavapai County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, **OR** Motion not to approve Resolution No. 1780. **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends authorizing signature of Resolution No. 1780 adopting and approving the 2011 updated Yavapai County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: There is not a direct fiscal impact to the Town for the adoption of the 2011 updated Yavapai County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.
