

RESOLUTION NO. 1817

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PRESCOTT VALLEY AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FY 2012 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT STATE SPECIAL PROJECT (SSP) ROUND II FUNDS, CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION MEETS THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the Town of Prescott Valley is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant State Special Projects (SSP) Program; and

WHEREAS, the State CDBG Program requires that CDBG funds requested address one of the three Congressional mandated National Objectives; and

WHEREAS, the activities within this application addresses the community's identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, an applicant of State CDBG funds is required to comply with the program guidelines and Federal Statutes and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Prescott Valley authorizes application to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing for FY 2012 CDBG SSP Round II funds, and authorizes the Mayor to sign the application and contract or grant documents for receipt and use of these funds for the "Loos Drive Sidewalk, Street, & Drainage Improvements Phase III", and authorizes the Mayor to take all actions necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said application; and

THAT this application for State CDBG SSP funds meets the requirements of low- and moderate-income benefit for activities justified as benefiting low- and moderate-income persons, aids in the prevention or elimination of slum and blight or addresses an urgent need which poses a threat to health; and

THAT, the Town of Prescott Valley will comply with all State CDBG Program guidelines, Federal Statutes and regulations applicable to the State CDBG Program and the certifications contained in the application.
